1	Tissues are processed to a minimum temperature of 80° C For at least 30 minutes			
2	Maximum moisture does not exceed 10% at the exit of the Cooker			
3	There are records of incoming raw material that include type and origin of the raw material, date, and quantity.			
4	There are records of time-temperature for each one of the processed lots			
5	There are records of exit moisture for each produced lots			
6	There are detailed sales records of the meals, which include: name of the marketing company, feed manufacturing plant, or producer who bought the product, as well as the corresponding receipt			
7	This point only applies to those rendering plants that process non ruminant tissues: there are control procedures to guaranty that by no circumstances and at any time process ruminant tissues			
8	The rendering plant is integrated to a slaughtering establishment
