

Crop Monitoring Course

Please read these Instructions before taking the Crop Monitoring Course.

- 1) On the AgLearn Home page verify your computer settings by clicking on the link below to assure that you have the minimum requirements to run the course. [New to AgLearn? Click here to check your computer's settings.](#) Please contact your local IT support staff if you need assistance to make any changes to your computer settings.

- 2) To open a module click on the “Launch Content” button. The module is automatically timed; however, you may use the forward symbol on the progress bar to forego automated movement.

You may move backward and forward within the module but you may not change a test question once you have selected the submit button on the question slide. Module 1 and Module 3 do not have test questions.

When you complete a module and arrive at the screen that displays the test score, click the NEXT button. This will take you to the last screen that will request that you click the EXIT button. Click on the “Learning Plan” to select the next module.

- 3) When you complete a module it is moved from your “Learning Plan” to your “Learning History.” If you exit a module before completion your return to the module will take you to a blank page. Use the rewind symbol on the progress bar to return to the cover page and proceed through the module.
- 4) If you are delayed from an open course for more than one hour, exit the module and exit AgLearn by moving to the upper right hand corner of your computer and clicking the white X located on the red background. AgLearn will time-out after a one hour delay in use.
- 5) You will be unable to print one certificate of completion for this training course. However, we offer an alternative. When you have completed the course please print the page (s) in your “Learning History” that displays the 16 modules. Each module shows the completion date which will meet our needs for training certification for 2006. Place this copy (s) in your training folders when all modules are completed.
