



# New Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) Courses

## FLRA Bargaining Over 5 U.S.C. Section 7106(b)(1) Matters

This training on bargaining over matters that fall under section 7106(b)(1) of the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute. Explore section 7106(b)(1) of the Statute in greater detail and identify subjects about which management is free to negotiate but is not required to negotiate.

## FLRA Basic Statutory Training: Rights & Obligations Under the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute

This course is divided into nine lessons to give you a basic understanding of the rights and obligations under the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute. The first and second lessons give you an overview of the FLRA Organization and the Unfair Labor Practice process. Lessons three through nine explore the rights and obligations under the Statute as it guides Labor Management Relations.

## FLRA Comprehensive Arbitration Training

This course will explore a primary responsibility of the Authority under the Federal Service Labor-Management Relations Statute to resolve exceptions to arbitration awards that arise out of grievances filed by a Federal employee, union or agency. This program is designed to help you understand the role of the arbitrator, the parties and the Authority in the arbitration process.

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
