

Due Process Rights

Establishments have the right to do business and are guaranteed due process of law. The Constitution guarantees that the government cannot take away a person's basic rights to 'life, liberty or property, without due process of law.' "***Due process rights***" means that a fair "*process*" or proceeding, must take place before the government interferes with an individual's property or actions. By following the Rules of Practice regulations, the FSIS assures that appropriate due process takes place.
