 <p>Statutes</p> <p>FMIA 623</p>	<p>FMIA 623 outlines several exemptions to inspection requirements for certain types of meat producers. Exemptions from inspection requirements include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal and custom slaughtering for personal, household, guest or employee uses • Slaughter or processing conducted by any person in a Territory lacking a legislative body if it is to be distributed solely within that Territory • Pizzas containing meat food products
 <p>Statutes</p> <p>PPIA 464</p>	<p>PPIA 464 details inspection requirement exemptions for poultry producers. These exemptions include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retail dealers that cut/slice poultry products for direct sale to consumers on their premises • Persons handling poultry/poultry products in accordance with recognized religious dietary laws • Poultry and poultry processing conducted by any person in a Territory lacking a legislative body if it is to be distributed solely within that Territory • Personal or custom slaughtering of poultry exclusively for the owner’s use by him and members of his household and his nonpaying guests and employees • Pizzas containing poultry products
 <p>Regulations</p> <p>9 CFR 303 (Livestock) 9 CFR Subpart C 381.10 (Poultry)</p>	<p>Main Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 CFR 303 details the livestock slaughter exemptions and explains how to determine the intensity of inspection coverage by evaluating the performance and the characteristics of the establishment. • 9 CFR 381.10 details inspection requirement exemptions for poultry producers.
 <p>Directives</p> <p>5930.1, Revision 3, Custom Review Process</p>	<p>Purpose:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes the policies and procedures for reviewing custom livestock or poultry slaughtering and processing operations that are exempt from inspection requirements under the Acts, and the actions that FSIS may take when custom exempt facilities and operators do not maintain compliance with the applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.
