
12. As the course loads, you will see this picture. The course should take no more than a few seconds to load.




13. In the lower right corner of the first page, click Begin Course. From this point forward follow the navigational instructions within the course to continue.

16. During the course, you will be asked to check your knowledge with questions and tests. Answer the questions, then click **Done** to review your feedback.




18. When you reach the end of the course, you will receive a message letting you know if you have met the defined completion criteria.


20. You can print the Test Score Report if you wish. Close the report window to return to the course.


25. Find your recently completed Security Awareness Training and click the corresponding **Print Completion Certificate** button.
